*Former applicants/winners are also eligible.

NOTES

1. Refer to the template on the website before writing your essay.

3. Do not write your name or anything that will identify yourself in the essay.
4. Your essay should be self-written and unpublished.
5. If you have references or citations, be sure to include them in a Works Cited page.
6. Fill out the cover page and submit it with your essay.
International students need to write their names in both English and Katakana.
7. Submitted essays will not be returned.
8. Winning essays will be published in the booklet issued by the Committee.
